In 1917, we had a simple idea. By campaigning for pedestrians to face oncoming traffic and walk on the right hand side of the road, we reduced fatalities by 70%.

Since then, we have campaigned, lobbied, trained and consulted on saving lives and reducing injuries, both at home and in the workplace.

We coined the phrase 'Safety First'; we created the Tufty Club and our famous squirrel's Kerb Drill: "Look left, look right and look left again", as well as devising and promoting the Cycling Proficiency Scheme.

Over the last 90 years, we've remained an instrumental force in every piece of UK safety legislation, and continue to set the standard in training the next generation of health and safety officers, through a wide variety of courses, events and initiatives.

We are a not-for-profit organisation with charitable status and are proud to have Her Majesty The Queen as our patron.

Our management courses and events help everyone from directors to first-line supervisors and managers keep up-to-date with the latest in best practice, and in understanding their corporate responsibilities.

At the same time, our lobbying and campaigning work has been instrumental in defining the parameters of what safety means in the modern world, playing an instrumental role in every piece of safety legislation since 1971.
